Adequate: sufficient; enough.

Annexed: taken over and controlled by a larger and more powerful country, territory, place, etc.

Berries: small fruit found on trees or bushes (often red in colour).

Citrus plantations: land where fruits like lemons and oranges are grown in large numbers.

Downtown: the centre of a city or town.

Flourished: did well; was abundant or plentiful.

Landmarks: important structures, such as buildings, or geographical features - rivers for example.

Municipality: city, town or district with its own government (council) and laws.

Relinquishing: giving up or surrendering something.

Secure a source of water: to get access to the place water comes from.

Significant attractions: important places to see; landmarks.

Trolley car: small train that runs on rails in the street; similar to “streetcar”; tram.

Utilise: make use of something that already exists; exploit.
